## **Taunton TSS:**

Non-smoking, short-term, 40-bed co-ed 24-hour residential transitional support services program, providing structured, supportive services using intensive case management, structured psycho-education, and recovery-oriented milieu management.

### **Services include**

- Psycho-educational groups
  - \* Relapse prevention groups
  - \* Health education groups
  - \* Self-help groups
  - \* Opioid overdose prevention
  - \* 12 Step education
- Referrals to recovery-oriented settings, including residential rehabilitation services, supportive transitional and/or permanent housing programs, or community-based treatment and/or recovery services
- Monitoring client self-administered medications
- Recreational activities
