

# SOAP

## (Structured Outpatient Addiction Program)

SOAP provides additional support as people work on recovery within their communities and families. The program offers

- Relapse prevention and daily coping skills
- Practical recovery skills
- Connection to community-based supports
- Health/wellness & self-care education
- Additional services, such as psychiatric care, medication-assisted treatment, children's behavioral health services, and home-based treatment
- Group therapy (trauma, anger management, parenting etc.)
- Family education and treatment
- Collaboration with DCF, probation, CSP (Community Support Services), and parole

SOAP accepts Beacon Health, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Boston Medical Center, Cenpatico, DPH, Fallon, MassHealth (MBHP), Neighborhood Health Plan, Network Health, Tufts Health Plans, United Behavioral Health
