What is the Process?

1. Call or walk in during 'open access'
2. Set up transportation to the clinic
3. Meet with a recovery coach/clinician to be screened
4. Get fast-tracked to High Point's continuum of care or be referred to community provider/s
5. Receive ongoing support throughout treatment
