~ Community Based Support Services (CBRS) for individuals with mental health concerns, providing community-based case management and connection to services

~ Recovery Coaches (RC): provide social and emotional support, as well as connections to the recovery community

~ REACH (Recovery, Education, and Access to Community Health): Blue Cross Blue Shield program, providing case management and flexible support services

How Can CBRS Support Me?

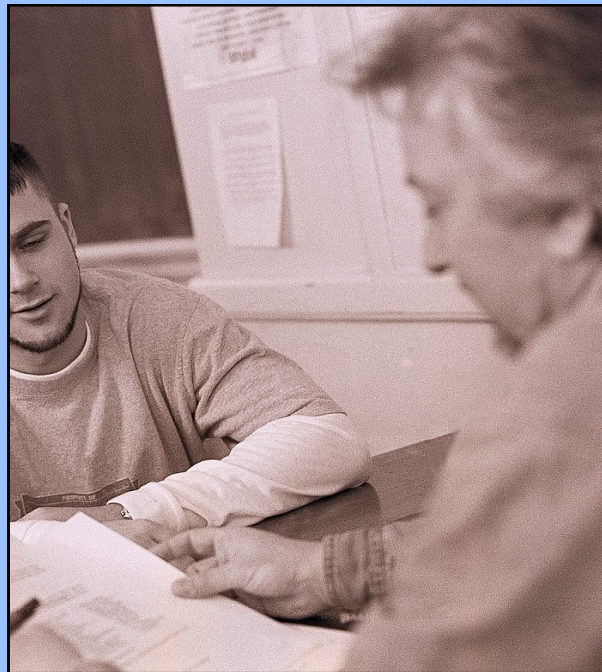

Am I Eligible for Services?

For CSP (Community Support Program) and Recovery Support Navigators: Individuals must have a mental health/substance use disorder diagnosis and either a recent inpatient stay or high risk factors that could lead to an inpatient stay.

For Recovery Coaches: Individuals must have a substance use disorder diagnosis, in addition to a desire to engage in the recovery process.



ACCEPTED INSURANCES

High Point accepts MassHealth (MBHP, Beacon, & Tufts- CSP/RSN/RC), some private insurances, self-pay, and offers a reduced fee/sliding scale to individuals who qualify.
